

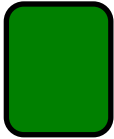
## TARGETS

Targets are painted metal signs (approximately 12" X 15") hanging from overhead span wires or bracket arms adjacent to the trolley wire. The purpose of the target is to govern the application of traction power or to indicate speed or other safety restrictions on the Como-Harriet Streetcar Line.

### Aspect

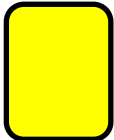
### Indication or meaning

Green



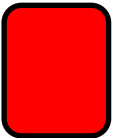
Power can be applied. Current track conditions, pedestrians or obstructions in front of or near the car's direction of movement, or other operating procedures/instructions, will govern the actual speed of the car.

Yellow



Shut off power and coast. Prepare to apply brakes if the next target's aspect is red or red with a white "S" painted on it.

Red



Reduce speed to four miles per hour (4 mph) or less as required, unless you are making a car stop.

White "S"



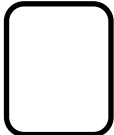
Absolute stop. End point of passenger operations.

For standard cars. At north platform (Lake Calhoun platform) stop with the front door on the platform.

For PCC No. 322. At north platform stop the car with the front door on the platform.

At Linden Hills car barn. During car barn open house only stop the car so that the rear or middle door (PCC No. 322) is on the brick walkway.

White



No meaning and is merely the back of another type of target.

**NOTE:** Operations and Safety Bulletins or other notices posted on the operations bulletin board in the maintenance barn (also found in the Linden Hills station agent's manual), or instructions given by the crew Foreman during his/her shift, that are more restrictive than the targets' indication/meaning, will supersede the target indication.
